

# Foster Family (Puppy Raiser) and Puppy Sitter Application

Thank you for applying to become a foster family or puppy sitter for Puppy Jake Foundation. Before completing this application please review this document so you understand our expectations of our foster families and puppy sitters.

Please read the following carefully:

As a Foster Family (puppy raiser), it is your responsibility to socialize and train a puppy for a span of 18-24 months under the instruction of a qualified trainer provided by Puppy Jake Foundation. The puppy will be expected to go everywhere with you, mimicking what their life will be like when they are placed with their veteran. You will also be expected to attend class each week.

As a puppy sitter, it is your responsibility to socialize and train a dog for short periods of time. While a dog is in your care you agree to take on all the responsibilities of a foster family (puppy raiser).

As a fill-in handler you would work dogs during a class, training retreat, or on a training trip when a foster family is unable to attend.

Puppy Jake Foundation puts a lot of pride into their training program for foster families, puppy sitters and fill-in handlers. By filling out this application you agree to be a foster family, puppy sitter, or fill-in handler exclusively for Puppy Jake Foundation.
