What a year -2020! Puppy Jake Foundation is not alone working through the various challenges posed by COVID-19 and we appreciate your continued assistance and support.

Unfortunately, all 10 of the annual fundraising events were cancelled due to the pandemic. Needless to say, this caused a major drop in donations, specifically a loss of \$200,000 in donations.

I am honored to share that PJF was able to carry-on and, respecting social distancing, hold training classes remotely and held Team Training.

February 2021 marks eight years of Puppy Jake Foundation working to help the lives of wounded Veterans with a service dog. Looking back over last year, I continue to be amazed at the growth and expansion of Puppy Jake Foundation. Four more Veterans received their service dogs in 2020, bringing the number to 27 working Veteran/service dog teams. I am pleased to share that the teams are working well together.

For the eighth year in a row, financial support from individuals and the community continues to remain strong. Having said that, the task of raising money is never ending. As PJF enters 2021, there are fifteen service dogs in various stages of training and projected arrival of new puppies. Simply put, fulfilling Puppy Jake Foundation's mission of providing professionally trained service dogs to wounded military Veterans would not occur without your support.

Puppy Jake Foundation is grateful and honored by all support and contributions. Serving as good stewards of financial resources is of utmost importance to the entire team. Donor policies and the IRS-990 are available on the website. PJF also undergoes an annual, independent audit. In addition to ADI accreditation, PJF is a member of the Better Business Bureau and has achieved the Platinum Star level from GuideStar.

Puppy Jake Foundation will strive to increase funding and profile in the coming year so we may help those brave men and women who have given so selflessly to protect our freedom.

Service Dog Etiquette:

What should you do when you see a Service Dog? What is proper Service Dog etiquette?

Smile and be polite to the Service Dog's handler, but most of all:

- Do not pet the Service Dog.
- Do not distract the Service Dog in any way.
- Please ignore the Service Dog entirely. You're not being rude if you don't acknowledge its presence.

Service Dog etiquette says when a Service Dog has a vest on or is in public with its disabled handler or trainer, it is working, even if it appears as though it is not. Distracting a Service Dog by making noises, offering food or water, toys or petting may be dangerous to the dog's disabled handler. And especially if the dog is a medical alert dog or brace/mobility support dog. Many handlers have "invisible disabilities," such as diabetes, hearing loss or other symptoms not readily apparent. If a Service Dog is paying attention to someone who's distracting it, then it's not doing its job for its handler.

If you would like to pet the Service Dog, ALWAYS ask the handler first, but don't be offended if they refuse. Some disabled Service Dog handlers don't like to chat about their Service Dogs. Most like to go about their day, just like you! Also, never ask personal questions about the handler's disability or intrude on their privacy. Keep these simple Service Dog etiquette tips in mind and you'll have a far smoother experience when you see a Service Dog in public.




Now this is what it's all about! Four Veterans and their new service dogs graduated in the summer of 2020.

Service Dog Etiquette:

What should you do when you see a Service Dog? What is proper Service Dog etiquette?

Smile and be polite to the Service Dog's handler, but most of all:

- Do not pet the Service Dog.
- Do not distract the Service Dog in any way.
- Please ignore the Service Dog entirely.
 You're not being rude if you don't acknowledge its presence.

Service Dog etiquette says when a Service Dog has a vest on or is in public with its disabled handler or trainer, it is working, even if it appears as though it is not. Distracting a Service Dog by making noises, offering food or water, toys or petting may be dangerous to the dog's disabled handler. And especially if the dog is a medical alert dog or brace/mobility support dog. Many handlers have "invisible disabilities," such as diabetes, hearing loss or other symptoms not readily apparent. If a Service Dog is paying attention to someone who's distracting it, then it's not doing its job for its handler.

If you would like to pet the Service Dog, ALWAYS ask the handler first, but don't be offended if they refuse. Some disabled Service Dog handlers don't like to chat about their Service Dogs. Most like to go about their day, just like you! Also, never ask personal questions about the handler's disability or intrude on their privacy. Keep these simple Service Dog etiquette tips in mind and you'll have a far smoother experience when you see a Service Dog in public.
