Thank you for your interest in receiving a service dog from the Puppy Jake Foundation (PJF), a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to helping military veterans through the assistance of well bred and professionally trained service dogs.

At this time, we only consider Applications of Interest from qualified military veterans. This application of interest is the first step in determining whether PJF can meet your needs. Once you have completed this application, a member of our veteran coordination team will be in contact with you. Check List

Before you begin, there are several items you need to submit with your Application of Interest:

- Photocopy of your most recent DD214 of NGB22
- Photocopy of your driver's license
- Doctors prescription that states a service dog would benefit your physical or mental health
- Completed mental health evaluation completed by your psychiatrist, physician or therapist
- Completed and signed medical release form

Please note: If your Application of Interest is approved, you will receive the full Application for a Service Dog. Along with required paperwork, a \$250 application fee will be required. This fee is the only funding we require. It demonstrates that you understand the seriousness of undertaking a service animal. If you cannot afford the application fee, assistance may be available.

At all times, applications are reviewed with a commitment to equality, diversity and inclusion to ensure fairness without regard to sex, sexual orientation, race, ethnicity, national origin, age, religion or any other legally protected classifications.

Application Process and Terms

Due to the time and resources it takes to train a service dog, there may be a considerable wait from the time your Application of Interest is approved for placement with a dog. We will do our best to keep you informed of your place in line, as well as the timing. Applications of Interest are reviewed 2-3 times a year ahead of dates when veterans are matched with available dogs.

Only complete applications will be considered.

Step 1: Complete and submit Application of Interest

Step 2: Meet by phone, Zoom video or in person with Veteran Coordination staff

Step 3: If your Application of Interest is accepted, you will move to Phase 2 of the application process and be asked to complete and submit an Application for Service Dog with a \$250 application fee.

Step 4: Interview and home visit

Step 5: Placed in queue for matching

Step 6: Once matched, there is a mandatory team training every second Saturday for five months at the PJF facility in Urbandale, Iowa. Following graduation from this training, there will be a follow up training for five months on the second Saturday of the month. All veterans receiving a Puppy Jake service dog must be able to attend all required training including one or more of your support team.

Step 7: Annual public access training at our facility in Urbandale
